Best Buddies for winning "Best Trunk Award" with their Toy Story theme.



# Staff Spotlight: Kuldeep Waraitch

This month, we want to recognize Whiteland High School's Punjabi Club, our October JCBank donation recipient, as well as their staff sponsor: Kuldeep Waraitch.

The Punjabi Club started three years ago with a goal to inform students and the community more about Punjabi culture and bring awareness. Led by **Kuldeep Waraitch who is in her 20<sup>th</sup> year as an ELS teacher**, the club holds two festivals a year, holds fundraisers, and makes goody bags for the student body.



When asked what she wishes the community knew about the club, Kuldeep spoke about correcting misconceptions. **Through this club, students have the opportunity to educate about Punjabi culture, language, and traditions.** Kuldeep referred to it as a "joyful club with joyful events, with a mission to spread love."
